The COVID-19 pandemic disrupts normal face-to-face social work services in Hong Kong but it creates new opportunities for social work services go digital. The current study aims to explore the relationship between social workers' digital competence, motivation of practicing digital services and perceived usefulness of using digital tools. The participants are social workers who are working in various organisations and service settings in Hong Kong. Results indicate that motivation of practicing digital services and perceived usefulness of using digital tools significantly predict the value of digital competence. The findings are discussed with relation to the technological acceptance model.



Dr. Kitty Mo Yuen Han obtained her doctoral degree in social work from The Hong Kong Polytechnic University. She is now an associate professor in the Department of Social Work, Hong Kong Shue Yan University. Dr. Mo investigates the use of technology in social service and social work supervision.
